NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$ MISO 427048 DEBT 002226 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of CITY OF COOPER.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$.849272 per \$100
NO-NEW REVENUE TAX RATE \$.849272 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$.871218 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for CITY OF COOPER from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that CITY OF COOPER may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that CITY OF COOPER is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON SEPT. 9, 2024 5:30PM at CITY HALL 911 N. BIDE SQUARE.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, CITY OF COOPER is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the CITY COUNCIL of CITY OF COOPER at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE TAX RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

Property tax amount = (tax rate) x (taxable value of your property) ÷ 100
