The City of Cooper has set Saturday, April 29<sup>TH</sup> through Saturday May 6<sup>TH</sup> as Clean Up Week. All charges will be half the normal price for residential pick-ups. **There will be no charge for residents that take items to the dumpsite themselves, excluding tires.** As always, there is **no charge** if you take brush to the dumpsite. The city will allow residents to take tires and batteries to the dumpsite. The fee for tires will be \$2.50 per tire for a regular size tire, \$10.00 per tire for semi-truck tires and \$60.00 for rear mount tractor tires. No tire will be accepted that is still mounted on the rim. There will not be a charge for batteries.

Tires and batteries will not be picked up at your residence.
