

2023 SPRING CLEAN UP WEEK SCHEDULE

YOU MUST BRING A COPY OF YOUR WATER BILL

The City of Cooper has set Saturday, April 29TH through Saturday May 6TH as Clean Up Week. All charges will be half the normal price for residential pick-ups. **There will be no charge for residents that take items to the dumpsite themselves, excluding tires.** As always, there is **no charge** if you take brush to the dumpsite. The city will allow residents to take tires and batteries to the dumpsite. The fee for tires will be \$2.50 per tire for a regular size tire, \$10.00 per tire for semi-truck tires and \$60.00 for rear mount tractor tires. No tire will be accepted that is still mounted on the rim. There will not be a charge for batteries.

Tires and batteries will not be picked up at your residence.

Thursday May 4th and Friday May 5th - 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

NO COMMERCIAL TRASH, BRUSH, TIRES OR BATTERIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DUMPSITE
